

Cannabidiol (CBD)

Within the growing cannabis industry is a new category of products seeing its own rise in popularity: cannabidiol hemp oil, or CBD hemp oil.

LEGALITY

- Medicinal or recreational use legal in some but not all states
- Laws may differ between federal and state level
- Some states have varying laws directly related to CBD oil
- Different states require different levels of prescription to possess and use CBD oil



HOW IT WORKS

- All cannabinoids, including CBD, attach themselves to receptors in the body - CB1 receptors and CB2 receptors.
- CB1 receptors are found all around the body, but many of them are in the brain.
 - Those in the brain deal with coordination and movement, pain, emotions and mood, thinking, appetite, and memories, among others. THC attaches to these receptors/
- CB2 receptors are more common in the immune system, they affect inflammation and pain
- CBD does not act on either receptor directly. Instead, it seems to influence the body to use more of its own cannabinoids.
