



Privacy Rights for Individual Citizens of the European Union or the European Economic Area

If you are an individual citizen of the European Union (“EU”) or the European Economic Area, you have the following rights under the General Data Protection Regulation, which is a EU law:

Right to be informed. You have a right to be informed about the collection and use of your personal data. You always have the choice to not disclose your personal data to us. Keep in mind, however, that some personal data is necessary to do business with us.

Right of access. You have a right to request a copy of your personal data that we have about you.

Right to rectification. If you believe the personal data we hold about you is inaccurate or incomplete, you can request for it to be changed. We may not accommodate a request to change information if we believe the change would violate any law or legal requirement or cause the information to be inaccurate.

Right to restrict processing. You have the right to request the restriction or suppression of your personal data. However, this is not an absolute right and only applies in certain circumstances.

Right to erasure and to be forgotten. You may request your personal data to be deleted. Your request may not be granted if there are business reasons for us to maintain your personal data such as regulatory requirements, recordkeeping needs, or responding to your inquiries for future service.

Right to data portability. You may request us to transfer your personal data to a third party if your information was collected under a contract or pursuant to your consent.

Right to object. You may object to the processing of your personal data where processing is necessary for: (i) tasks carried out in the public interest; (ii) exercise of an official authority vested in the controller; (iii) purposes of legitimate interests (except where such interests are overcome by your interests or fundamental rights and freedoms – especially if you are a child).
